

Your Tree Measurements

Here's a place to record your tree measurements so that you have them when you get the link to the data portal. Please refer to the *Instructions for Measuring Your Trees* for how to do these measurements.

We are asking for some measurements to the nearest foot. Your tape measure has markings in inches; remember 12 inches=1 foot!
